



Oral-B Vitality O-Ring Seal Replacement

This guide will show you how to remove the top of the handle and replace the O-Ring seal.

INTRODUCTION

Electric toothbrushes have one or more O-rings to prevent water from entering the handle and damaging electric parts in the handle. If the O-ring wears out, you'll see water seeping through the handle during use.

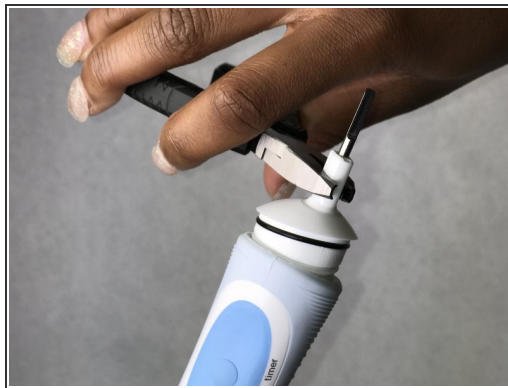

15/16" ID, 1/16" Width
*Water- and Steam Resistant Food Grade
EPDM O-Ring, McMaster-Carr PN: 9561K23*

Step 1 — O-Ring Seal



- Remove the the brush head from the handle.

Step 2



- Using the pliers, rotate the head base 90 degrees counterclockwise and remove core from the handle.

Step 3



- Using a spudger, remove the old O-Ring from the white head.
- ⓘ Replace with, McMaster-Carr PN:9561K23. O-Ring: 15/16" ID, 1/16" Width. Food and Steam Resistant Food Grade EPDM O-Ring.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
