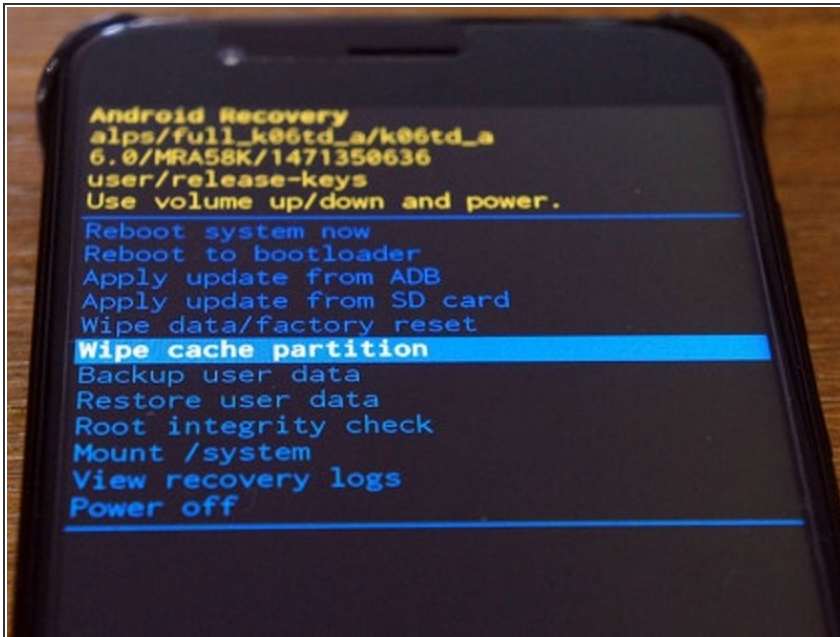

INTRODUCTION

Sometimes you need to clear the cache, for example when an OTA update hangs instead of rebooting.

Step 1 — How to clear your cache



- Shut down your phone by holding Power and tapping Power Off
- ❗ Wait for the phone to vibrate once
- Hold down Volume Up then Power until you see **Recovery <<==**
- If the arrow does not point at Recovery press Volume Up until it does
- Press Volume Down and wait a few seconds
- When you see **No command**, hold Power and Volume Up until you see the menu shown
- Choose **Wipe cache partition** using Volume Up/Down then Power
- Choose **Reboot system now** using Volume Up/Down then Power
