



Simple Jean Hole Repair

Patching a small hole in a pair of jeans without sewing. Involves using a piece of fabric, adhesive bonding tape, and an iron.

INTRODUCTION

This guide will demonstrate how to patch a hole in a pair of jeans. This is an easy fix that does not involve sewing on fabric. This fix will take about 10 minutes.

TOOLS:

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Step 1 — Simple Jean Hole Repair



- Turn the jeans inside out.

Step 2



- Measure the size of the hole and cut the appropriate amount of the fabric needed.

Step 3



- Apply the adhesive bonding tape around the perimeter of the hole.

Step 4



- Align the piece of fabric on top of the adhesive bonding tape.

Step 5



- Place the hot iron over the fabric for 10 second intervals. Continue to iron until the fabric is secured.

 The iron will be hot, please use carefully.

Step 6



- Once the fabric is secured, turn the jeans right side out.

The fix will be complete once the fabric is well secured.
