
- Heat Shrink Tubing Assortment (1)
- Noctua NF-A4x20 PWM Premium-Quality Quiet 40mm Fan (1)
- Solder (1)

Step 1 — Unscrew the Outer Case




4 Screws on each side

Step 2 — Remove Fan




- 2 Screws
- 1 Pull cable

Step 3 — Cut Off Connector from both the old and new fan




 Leave some length to solder with and to reach connector on main board.


Step 4 — Prep Fan Wires and Connector Wires




 Strip Wires, Tin Wires, and prep by adding heat shrink tubing on wires (before shrinking).

Step 5 — **Solder Connecter to Fan**







- Solder the new fan to the old connector using the following pinout.
- Adjust heat shrink tubing so it covers the solder joints and use heat gun to shrink tubing.


Step 6 — Re-assemble fan to device with fan label facing out





Re-assemble fan to device with fan label facing out.

Step 7 — OPTIONAL - Use Small Round Nose Pliers to break off case grill to make fan even quieter

Step 8 — Re-Assemble Case
