


Holmes 16 Inch 4-in-1 Fan Teardown

This guide breaks down the process of taking apart of a Holmes 16 Inch 4-in-1 Fan.


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove Frame



- Remove holding pin on outer part of fan
- Pull apart front frame from back frame

Step 2 — Detach Motor Housing from Downrod



- Remove screws connecting the motor housing to the downrod
- Detach housing from downrod
- Note: Oscillation Control will no longer function

Step 3 — Remove Motor Casing



- Remove Oscillation Control pin
- Remove back screw
- Remove Motor Casing

Step 4 — Disconnect Stator from Rotor



- Remove the four screws connecting the stator to the rotor. The top two are displayed.
- Detach the stator from the rotor.
- Note: the fan will no longer operate.
