

How to enter Bluetooth Debug Menu and Factory Reset Apple Devices





## Step 1 — Reset Bluetooth Module or Factory Reset All Connected Apple Devices







- First enable the Bluetooth Icon in the Menu Bar
- Click the Launchpad icon in the Dock, and then navigate to "System Preferences" "Bluetooth".
- Click the checkbox next to "Show Bluetooth in Menu Bar" to enable it.

## Step 2







- Press and hold the Shift + Option keys on your Mac's keyboard and click the Bluetooth symbol in the top-right corner of the macOS menu bar.
- Locate the revealed Debug submenu and hover your mouse cursor over it.
- If you have problem with a connected Bluetooth device you can reset the Bluetooth module entirely from the Debug menu. This will wipe the Bluetooth configuration, reset the Bluetooth hardware, and disconnect any connected Bluetooth devices.
- If you want to fix a problem with connected Apple device then try the second menu. It works only the device is connected an only for Apple devices!

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
