


Samsung Galaxy S21 Teardown

INTRODUCTION

The Samsung Galaxy S21 might look like just a refreshed S20, but in a lot of ways it's the most interesting phone of the S21 lineup. It's less expensive than the Ultra and Plus, but it still gets the upgraded in-display fingerprint sensor from Qualcomm, some new display tech, and the new Snapdragon 888 processor with its integrated 5G modem—also from Qualcomm. What other surprises will we find inside? Let's teardown the Galaxy S21 and find out.

Step 1 — Final Thoughts



- The fasteners, all identical Phillips screws, only require one driver and can't be mixed up, simplifying repair.
- Many components are modular and independently replaceable, but the missing headphone jack means double duty and wear for the USB-C port.
- The two most common repairs, screen and battery, are still unnecessarily sticky and complicated

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
