## Step 1 - Front and Rear Casing



- Unscrew five Phillips screws using a \#0 Phillips screwdriver.
(i) One screw is on upper right corner of the back panel.
(i) The other four screws are on the bottom of the camera.


## Step 2



- Open the memory card cover by moving the slide switch toward the top end of of the camera.
- Remove the memory card from the slot.


## Step 3



- Remove the rear cover from the rest of the camera.
(i) This may require gentle rocking of the case to free it.

Step 4


- Unscrew the four Phillips screws from the side of the casing and one screw from the bottom using a \#0 Phillips screwdriver.


## Step 5



- Free the front cover from the rest of the camera.
(i) The cover may require gentle rocking to remove.
