INTRODUCTION


This guide will show you how to access the LCD screen in order to repair or replace the screen.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Paper Clip (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover



- Remove Memory Stick Pro from the card reader slot on the bottom of the camera.
- Remove both batteries.

Step 2






- Remove the single visible screw from both sides of the camera.
- Remove the two screws that are adjacent to the warning label, which is on the underside of the camera.
- (i) Do **NOT** remove all four screws from the bottom.


Step 3





- Gently remove the back cover from the camera.
- i The first time the case is removed, it will be stiff. Be patient and gently rock the cover back and forth until it slides free.


Step 4 — LCD Screen






Remove the two screws holding the circuit board down.

Step 5



- Detach the orange cable from the board.
- Use a thin object, like a paperclip, to gently pry the cable off the connector.


Step 6





- The LCD screen sits in two slots; one on the bottom, and one on the left edge.
- Slide LCD screen from the two slots.
- ♠ Do not attempt to completely remove the screen, as it is still attached to the camera.

Step 7







- To remove the LCD screen, detach the orange cable from the board.
- If needed, replace the LCD screen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
