INTRODUCTION

All the buttons on the tablet are located in one corner. They are all controlled by a button module board, which can be removed if desired.



TOOLS:


- Tweezers (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Rear Cover





- Separate the tablet from the base by pressing the large silver button below the tablet. The silver button is located at the base of the tablet.
- Remove the tablet by lifting up.




- Insert the opening tool into the seam of the tablet casing and gently pry upwards.
- With a little force, you will feel the clips release.

Step 3




- Slide the tool along all four edges of the tablet, making sure that all the clips are released.
- ♠ Do not break these clips; otherwise, the screen will become less secure.






Remove the rear casing.

Step 5 — Button Module



 Unclip the white connection clip using a pair of tweezers.



Pull the connection apparatus from the connection clip on the board using a pair of tweezers.


Step 7



 Gently fold the connection apparatus back away from your work area.







- Remove the screws using a Phillips Head #1 screwdriver.
- Remove the power button module.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
