INTRODUCTION

TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Motherboard






Remove the four 0.8mm Phillips #00 screws from the back cover.


Step 2



 Remove the two screws on top of the motherboard and the two screws on bottom of motherboard


Step 3






Detach the wires from their combs on the motherboard.


Step 4



 Detach from comb that is located on motherboard.


Step 5






Remove the small piece from the motherboard.

Step 6



 Use tweezers to remove last piece from the comb on the motherboard.

Step 7



 Remove the motherboard by simply lifting it.
