### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide shows how to remove everything from the display assembly.


#### TOOLS:

iFixit Opening Tool (1)
Spudger (1)
Tweezers (1)
Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
iOpener (1)
iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1)

## PARTS:

Galaxy Note 3 (T-Mobile/AT&T) Screen (1)
Galaxy Note 3 (Sprint/Verizon) Screen (1)
Galaxy Note 3 Vibrator (Verizon/Sprint) (1)
NuGlas Tempered Glass Screen
Protector for Galaxy Note 3 (1)
Galaxy Note 3 AMOLED and Digitizer (1)

### Step 1 — Remove the rear case



 Insert a fingernail or plastic opening tool in the gap between the rear case and the base of the phone.

## Step 2 — Remove Case from the Base





- Slide your fingernail or plastic opening tool along the edge of the rear case.
- Lift the case gently from the base.

## Step 3 — Battery





- Insert a fingernail or plastic opening tool into the small gap between the battery and the phone base.
- Lift the battery out of its recess.

# Step 4 — S Pen



- Place your fingernail in the groove of the stylus pen.
- Pull the stylus pen away from the phone.

# **Step 5 — Unscrew Back Chassis**



• Remove the twelve 4mm Phillips #00 screws from the back chassis.

## Step 6 — Remove Back Chassis



- Insert the plastic opening tool into the Stylus Pen placement holder.
- Lift the plastic opening tool so that the midframe separates from the base.

## **Step 7 — Screw Removal**





Remove the single screw beside headphone jack.

# **Step 8 — Unfasten Clips and Cable Connectors**





- Use <u>tweezers</u> to remove both antenna clips.
- Use a spudger to disconnect six cable connectors.

# Step 9 — Motherboard Removal



• Pull up on the motherboard with tweezers.

# Step 10 — Spudger Tool Placement




• Insert the spudger into the headphone jack.

# Step 11 — Lift to Separate Headphone Jack




- Lift the spudger to separate the jack assembly from the motherboard.
- Pull to remove.

## **Step 12** — **Metal Bracket Removal**



 Remove the metal bracket located in the top left hand corner.

# **Step 13** — **Remove Vibrating Motor**



 Remove the vibrating motor by pulling up on it carefully with the <u>tweezers</u>.

## Step 14 — USB Port Removal



 Lift USB port from the front assembly using the tweezers.

# **Step 15 — Display Assembly**



 You are now left with the display assembly.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
