INTRODUCTION



Step 1 — Position



- Position the phone face-down.


Step 2 — Rear Case Removal



- Hold the phone in your hand and position your fingernail or a opening tool under the lip at the bottom of the case.
- Pry rear case upwards until you hear a click.
- Remove rear case.

Step 3 — Battery Removal



- Place the phone face-down.
- Place your thumb or tool in the indentation and remove the battery.

Step 4 — Unscrew The Bottom



- Remove the three screws from the bottom of the phone to unscrew the speaker.

Step 5 — Remove Speaker



- Place a prying tool between the speaker and the phone.
- Gently lift the speaker out of the phone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
