

# **Motorola V2397 Front Cover Replacement**

If your front cover cracks follow this guide to replace it. (Remove speaker depending on whether your new front case has a speaker included)

- T4 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

## Step 1 — Battery







- Press and hold the button on the battery cover
- Pull the battery cover down and out to remove it

# Step 2





Remove the batteries by pulling them away from the phone


#### Step 3 — Back Cover






Using the Torx T4 screwdriver remove the six screws highlighted in the picture to the left


# Step 4





Use your fingers or a spudger to remove the back cover


#### Step 5 — Side Buttons





Lift and remove buttons by hand

#### Step 6 — Phone





- Place your plastic opening tool in between the motherboard and the front cover of the phone
- Apply a small force to lift the motherboard away from the front cover

## Step 7 — Keypad







- Grip the top of the rubber keypad with your thumb and index finger
- While holding the keypad start to peel it back from the front cover until the keypad is completely detached

## Step 8 — Speaker





Use the iFixit opening tool to lift the speaker off the front cover.

# Step 9 — Front Cover





 Once the motherboard, speaker, and keypad have been removed you should have the front cover by itself

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
