

Asus X200MA Keyboard Assembly Replacement

TOOLS:

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1) Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Back Panel



- Remove the following six screws:
 - Six 4 mm screws using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.
- Remove the following one screw:
 - One 14 mm screw using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.
- The 14mm screw goes in the center.

Step 2



- Take two rubber caps off the back side of the laptop.
- Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the two 14 mm screws under the rubber caps.

Step 3



 Use a plastic or metal spudger to separate the keyboard from the back panel and lift the keyboard out of place.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
