


How to Fix a Broken Necklace Chain

INTRODUCTION


Have a broken necklace still lying around because you can't bear to get rid of it? This simple guide to repairing the chain will make it wearable again in no time.




TOOLS:

• Small Needle Nose Pliers (1)


Step 1 — How to Fix a Broken Necklace Chain






- Examine the break.
 - (i) If there is an open link in the chain, skip to step three.

Step 2








- Use the needle nosed pliers to separate the closure of a link on one side of the break.
 - You do not need this step if your necklace already has an open link.

Step 3




Hook the closed link opposite the break to the open link.

Step 4




- Using the needle nosed pliers, squeeze the ends of the open link together.
 - (i) Make sure the closed link is inside the open link.

Step 5



 Using the needle nosed pliers, squeeze the closure so that the ends of the link are flush with one another.

Step 6



• Test the closure by gently pulling it from either side. If it comes apart repeat steps 4 and 5.

Now you're ready to flaunt your old necklace once again!
