#### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will show you the steps to removing and replacing the earpiece speaker inside the Samsung Galaxy Media Player 5 device.

#### TOOLS:

PARTS:

Galaxy Player 5.0 Small Speaker (1)

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1) Tweezers (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1) iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1)

### Step 1 — Earpiece Speaker



A Remove the SD Memory Card before working on the device.

• Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the 10 mm screw near the SD Memory Card port.

## Step 2



- White caps cover screws on both sides of the charging port. Use the angled tweezers to remove them.
- if necessary to loosen the adhesive.


# Step 3



• Using a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the two 10 mm screws located on either side of the charging port.

# Step 4








- Using the opening pick, pry at the bottom and work around each edge of the device until the front cover and back cover housing is separated.
- ② You will hear a popping sound to indicate the separation.


# Step 5





• Using the plastic opening tool, apply an upward force to detach the battery and the tab attached to it.

## Step 6







- Using the plastic opening tool, apply an upward force to detach the speaker earpiece.
- Use the tweezers to attach the new earpiece speaker in place of the original.
  - i Use a blow dryer, on low heat settings, to loosen the adhesive on the speaker earpiece.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
