

Propel Gyro-X Top Propellor Blades Replacement

INTRODUCTION

In this guide you will learn how to remove and replace the top two propellor blades of the Gyro-X. This is a common procedure, because crashing your Gyro-X will often result in propellor damage. To remove the propellors you will only need to remove 4 small screws. Be careful not to lose these after removal.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Top Propellor Blades



- Stabilizing links are easy to break. Be gentle when prying them off.
 - Place the tweezers on the sides of the links and pull straight away from the top point of connection.

Step 2





Remove the two 6.0 mm Phillips #00 screws from the rotors.

Step 3





Pull the rotors away from the mounting brackets.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
