


Polaroid S10 Speaker Replacement

This guide will show how to replace any bad speakers in the Polaroid S10.

INTRODUCTION

People like to play their music and sometimes they play it too loud and it blows out their speakers. This will show you how to replace them.



TOOLS:

- Soldering Iron (1)
- 64 Bit Driver Kit (1)
- Spudger (1)
- Metal Spudger Set (1)
- iFixit Opening Picks set of 6 (1)
- Heavy-Duty Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Removing the backcover







- Place an opening pick between the volume button and the back cover.
- (i) More than one pick may be needed, but avoid placing more than two picks in the same space.
- Texcessive force on the pick will break the volume button.
- Carefully remove the back cover using the metal spudger.
- (i) It is normal to hear a snapping noise due to the plastic tabs on the back cover.


Step 2 — Speaker Assembly






- Use a heavy-duty nylon spudger to remove the tape.
- Unscrew the four 5 mm screws with the J000 screwdriver that connects the speakers.

Step 3 — **Desoldering the Speakers**





- Carefully desolder the 4 connections of the speakers.
- ♠ Do not touch the soldering iron to the motherboard or LCD screen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
