
INTRODUCTION

Unlike some laptops that have their keyboard built-in, Thinkpad keyboards can be easily removed in just a few steps.

TOOLS:

- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)
 - [Spudger](#) (1)

Step 1 — Keyboard



- Remove the eight 14mm screws using the Phillips #0 Screwdriver.

Step 2



- Lift the palm rest panel.
- ⚠ Lift the palm rest panel **slowly**; there is a ribbon cable connected under it.


Step 3



- While lifting the panel, lift the keyboard up.

⚠ Be sure to lift the keyboard **slowly**; there is a ribbon cable attached under it.

Step 4



- Use the spudger to disconnect the ribbon cable.

Step 5



- Remove the keyboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
