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INTRODUCTION


The viewfinder is the square piece on top of the camera that houses a square glass eye that you look through to see what you are taking a photo of.

TOOLS:

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
• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Back Lens of the Viewfinder



 Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the two 20 mm screws on the back of the viewfinder.

Step 2



- Remove the back cover of the viewfinder.
- Push out the lens that is flush with the back of the viewfinder cover.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
