INTRODUCTION

If the back cover of the Pentax PZ-10 won't lock in place, the spring that holds the door in place may need to be replaced.




iFixit Opening Tool (1) 64 Bit Driver Kit (1)

Step 1 — Removing the Bottom Cover



- With the lens face up and the bottom panel of the camera facing you, remove the two 7mm screws on the left using the J0 screwdriver.
- Remove the six 4.3mm screws in the middle and right of the panel using the J0 screwdriver.
- Pull off the bottom casing to remove.

Step 2 — Removing Bottom Casing



 With the screws removed, the bottom casing should come off very easily by pulling on the casing.

Step 3 — Removing the Back Cover



- i Place the camera on its side so the lens is facing left.
- Press down on the locking switch on the side panel facing you.


• With the door unlocked, rotate the device to access the bottom.

Step 5



- Using a pair of <u>tweezers</u>, gently remove the metal tab securing the back door axle.
- ⚠ The door will come loose at this point, watch for any loose parts that may also come out.

Step 6 — Removing the Side Panel



 Once the back cover is fully removed, remove the two
4.35mm screws attaching the cover of the unlocking switch, and remove the plate.

Step 7 — Removing the Spring



- Locate the spring at the upper left corner of the face, and pull the rings of the spring off of the pins to remove it using plastic opening tools.
- (i) You are now ready to replace the spring.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
