

MacBook Air 13" Late 2010 Lower Case Replacement

Replace the lower case on your MacBook Air 13" Late 2010.

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INTRODUCTION

Remove the lower case to access your MacBook Air's internals.



TOOLS:

 P5 Pentalobe Screwdriver Retina MacBook Pro and Air (1)



PARTS:

- MacBook Air 13" (Late 2010/Mid 2011)
 Lower Case (1)
- MacBook Air 13" Late 2010 to 2017 Lower Case Screw Set (1)
- MacBook Air Rubber Feet (1)

Step 1 — Lower Case



- Before proceeding, power off the device, close the lid and lay it on a soft surface top-side down.
 - Remove the following ten screws:
 - Two 9 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
 - Eight 2.6 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
- *i* The special screwdriver needed to remove the eight 5-point Pentalobe screws can be found here.

Step 2



- Wedge your fingers between the display and the lower case and pull upward to pop the lower case off the Air.
- Remove the lower case and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
