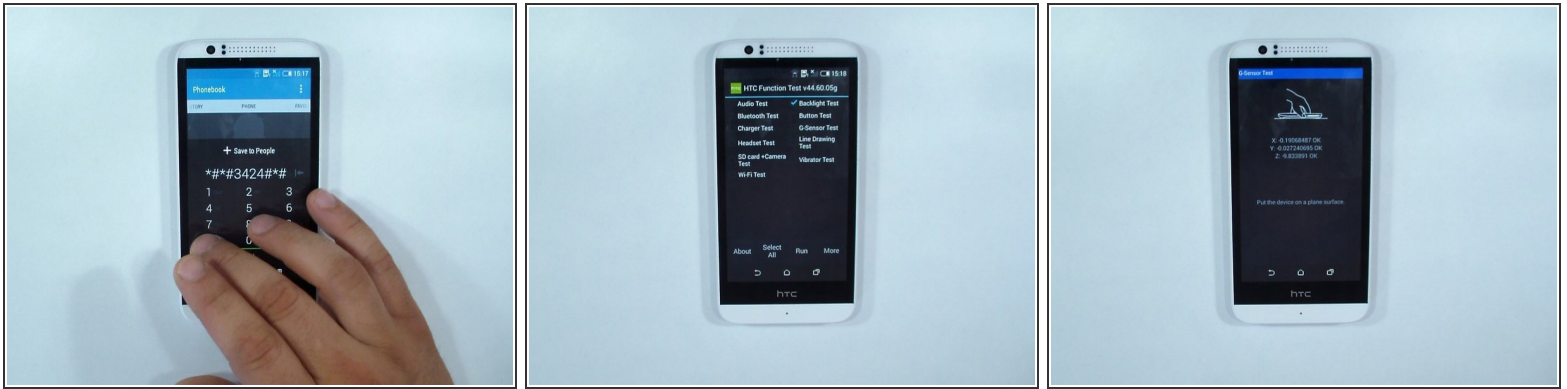


INTRODUCTION

- 1. Test Menu** - lets you troubleshoot hardware issues and check your phone's functionality.
- 2. Safe Mode** - all third-party apps are disabled and some settings are temporally rolled back to default settings
- 3. Developer Options** - In this menu you will find settings used for debugging and application development (like enable USB debugging). Do NOT change the settings unless you know what you are doing !!!
- 4. Info Menu** - Phone and battery information, usage statistic and Wi-Fi information.
- 5. Snapshot** - If you want to share what you see on your phone to a friend, or to save something for future reference.

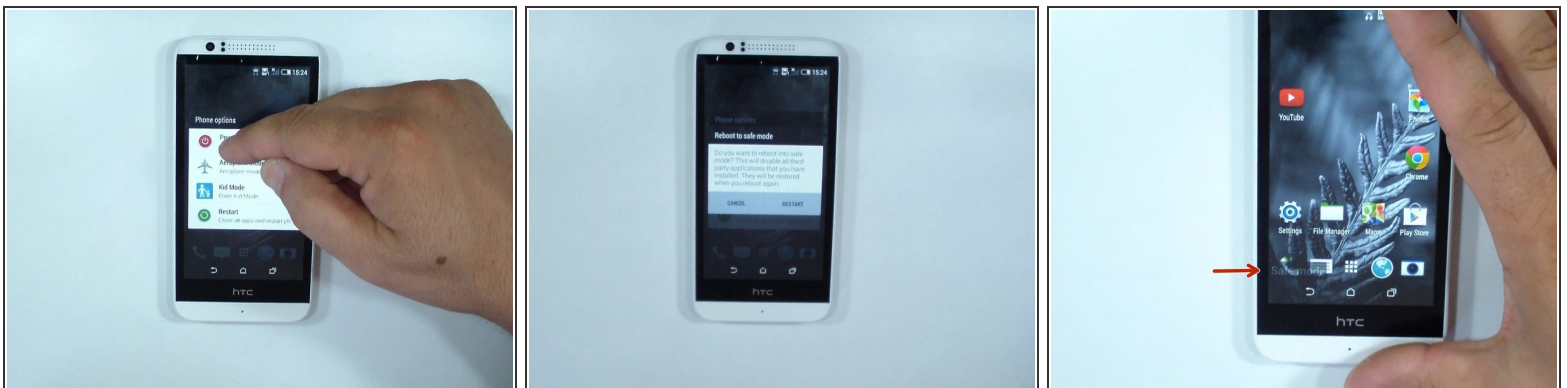

Step 1 — TEST MENU



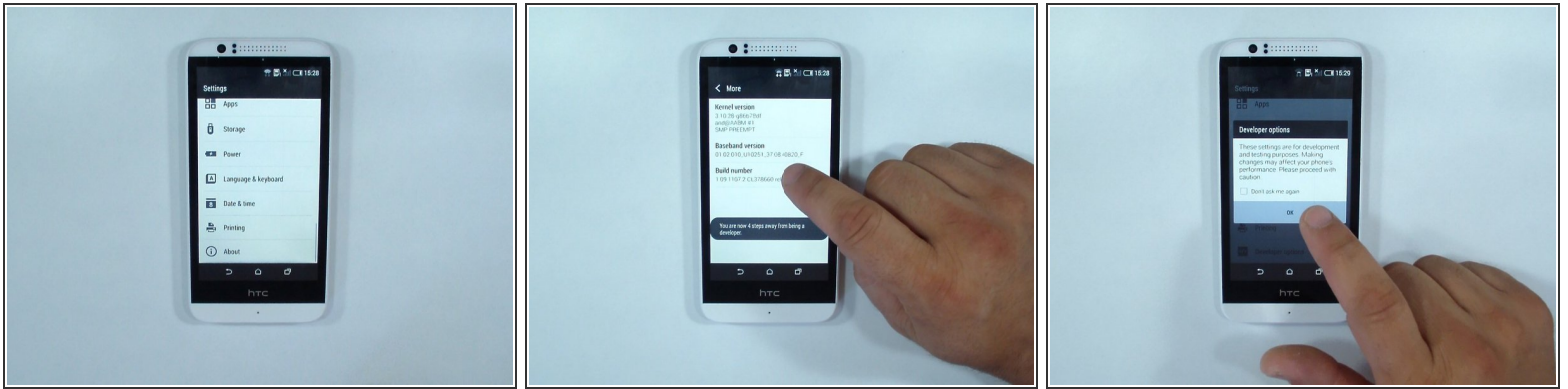
- Open the dialer app and enter this code:
- *#*#3424#*#*

Step 2 — SAFE MODE



- Open Power off menu.
- Tap and hold Power off option until you see Reboot to safe mode menu and select Restart.
- The phone will restart to safe mode.
- To turn off Safe mode, remove the battery.

Step 3 — DEVELOPER OPTIONS



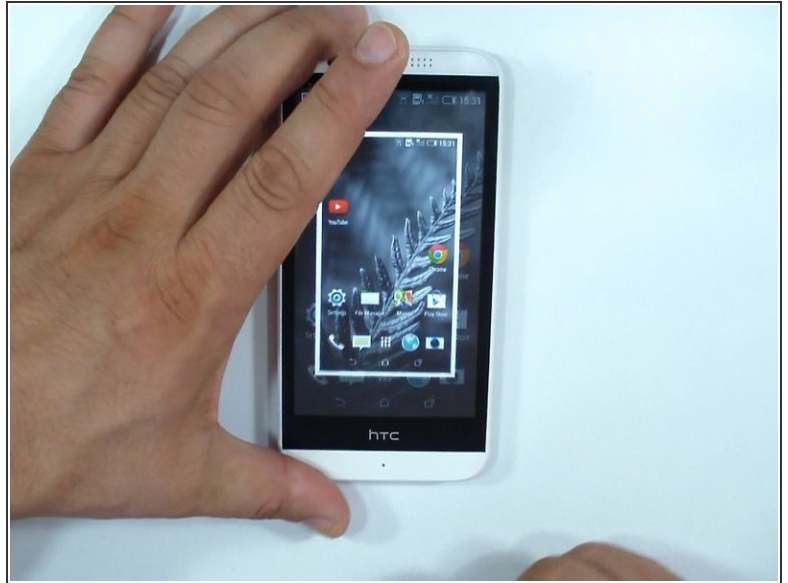
- > Settings
 - > About
 - > Software Information
 - > More
 - Tap Build number 7 times.
 - Your Developer options menu is unlocked. In this menu you will find settings used for debugging and application development.
 - If you want to root the phone, you have to enable USB debugging from this menu.
- ⚠ Do NOT change the settings unless you know what you are doing.

Step 4 — INFO MENU



- From the dealer app enter this code:
 - `*##4636##`
- Here you will find some helpful information for your device.

Step 5 — SNAPSHOT



- To make a screenshot press simultaneously:
 - Volume Down + Power or
 - Home + Powe
 - .

 - .
 - That's all.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
