


Holmes box fan motor replacement

A quick and easy guide to replace the motor of your Holmes box fan

INTRODUCTION


This is a very simple guide that will help you dissasemble and replace the motor of your Holmes box fan, this process is easy and it only requires a screwdriver and a new motor to install.



Step 1 — Motor








- The first step is to make sure you unplug your fan from the outlet.
- Make sure you also unplug the power cord from the back of the fan.


Step 2





- Now that your fan is unplugged, lay it flat with the brand label facing upward.
- Next is to remove the front cover.
- Remove the six screws from the perimeter of the cover in order to remove the front cover.


Step 3






- Next is the back cover.
- Flip over the fan so you have access to these six screws.
- Remove the six screws from the perimeter of the cover in order to remove the back cover.

Step 4




 Remove these four screws in order to remove the motor and fan blades from the housing.

Step 5



 The housing should now be able to lift away from the motor and fan blade.

Step 6







- The next step is to remove the mounts that held the motor to the housing.
- Remove these four screws to remove the mounts.

Step 7





Now you are able to remove the motor from the fan blades.

♠ Be careful, if you used your fan recently the motor may be quite hot.

Step 8



Now you can insert your new motor and you are done! To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
