


# Panasonic ER-GN30-K Motor Shaft Replacement

Is your blade not spinning when you turn on...

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Is your blade not spinning when you turn on your device, even when you hear the motor run? Check out this guide to replace your motor shaft.

### TOOLS:

Tweezers (1) Metal Spudger (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

### Step 1 — Motor Shaft



• Remove the dark transparent cap by gently pulling on it.

### Step 2



 Remove the back battery cap from the device by twisting it to the unlock position and pulling.

## Step 3



 Remove the black trimmer cap from the top of the device by gently pulling it.

### Step 4



- (i) The motor shaft should be sticking out from the top of the device.
- Use the metal prying tool to pry apart the silver plastic case .
- Pull each side of the plastic case off.

### Step 5




• Unscrew one 20mm Phillips #00 screw.

### Step 6



 Remove the rubber stopper from the top of the motor shaft by gently pulling it off.

### Step 7



• Use a pair of <u>tweezers</u> to remove the plastic cover of the motor shaft by pulling it away from the motor.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
