### **INTRODUCTION**

Is the lens mount in your camera damaged or broken? It might be time to replace it with a new one! This guide will explain how to replace the lens mount (also known as bayonet mount) in a Nikon N80/F80 Camera.



# **TOOLS:**

Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

## **Step 1 — Lens Mount (aka Bayonet Mount)**



 Make sure the On/Off switch is in the Off position.

## Step 2



- Place the camera so the lens is facing up.
- if your camera has a lens on, remove it by pushing and holding the lens release button and turning the lens clockwise until it comes off.

# Step 3



 Use a PH00 Phillips screwdriver to remove the five 4.8mm screws on the silver lens mount.

# Step 4



 Remove the old lens mount and place the new one on.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
