


Sony PlayStation 3D Display Indicator Light Bar Replacement

This guide will show you how to replace the indicator light bar.

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INTRODUCTION

This repair may be needed if your device functions properly, but the indicator lights do not work.

TOOLS:


- Metal Spudger (1)
- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Rear Case



• Remove the base by pushing in the button and sliding out the unit.

Step 2



• Remove USB port cover from back plate with a metal spudger.


(i) This will prevent the cover from falling under the back plate once it is removed.

Step 3




- With the Phillips #02 screwdriver, remove the six 6 mm length x 6 mm head screws from the back plate.
- With the Phillips #02 screwdriver, remove the ten 6 mm length x 8 mm head screws from the back plate.
 - (i) These screws have different threads and need to be kept separate.

Step 4




- Remove back plate with a plastic opening tool by slowing prying around the entire plate.
 A Be gentle to avoid breaking the plastic clips which hold the plate.
- Once separated the plate easily lifts off.

Step 5 — Indicator Light Bar



With the Phillips #02 screwdriver, remove the two 5mm length x 5mm head screws located on the left and right side of the light bar board.

Step 6



• Remove the light bar by depressing the tab on the white data connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
