


Magellan RoadMate 2120T-LM Motherboard Replacement

Instructions for replacing the motherboard of the Magellan RoadMate 2120T-LM

INTRODUCTION

This guide will walk through the steps of replacing the internal battery for a Magellan RoadMate 2120T-LM. Before starting, ensure that the new battery is supported by the device.



TOOLS:

- Heavy-Duty Spudger (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery







Turn the GPS over on its backside and remove the six 3 mm Phillips #1 screws.


Step 2






Pry up on back panel with black spudger

Step 3



 Disconnect battery and speaker cables from the motherboard at indicated places.

Step 4



- Use a spudger to remove the battery from the back panel.
- If at all possible, please try to use a regular nylon spudger before resorting to a metal spudger. Metal spudgers are much sharper, and have the potential to accidentally pierce the battery.
- There is a strong adhesive holding the battery to the back panel.
- This step is not a prerequisite for replacement of other components.

Step 5 — Motherboard




- Remove the four 3 mm Phillips #1 screws from the motherboard.
- in the picture three out of four screws have already been removed.

Step 6



Remove black tape covering connection ribbon for touch-screen

Step 7







- Pull up on the brown tab holding down the ribbon.
- (i) In this picture the brown tab has already been lifted.
- Lift up on the motherboard and remove it from device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
