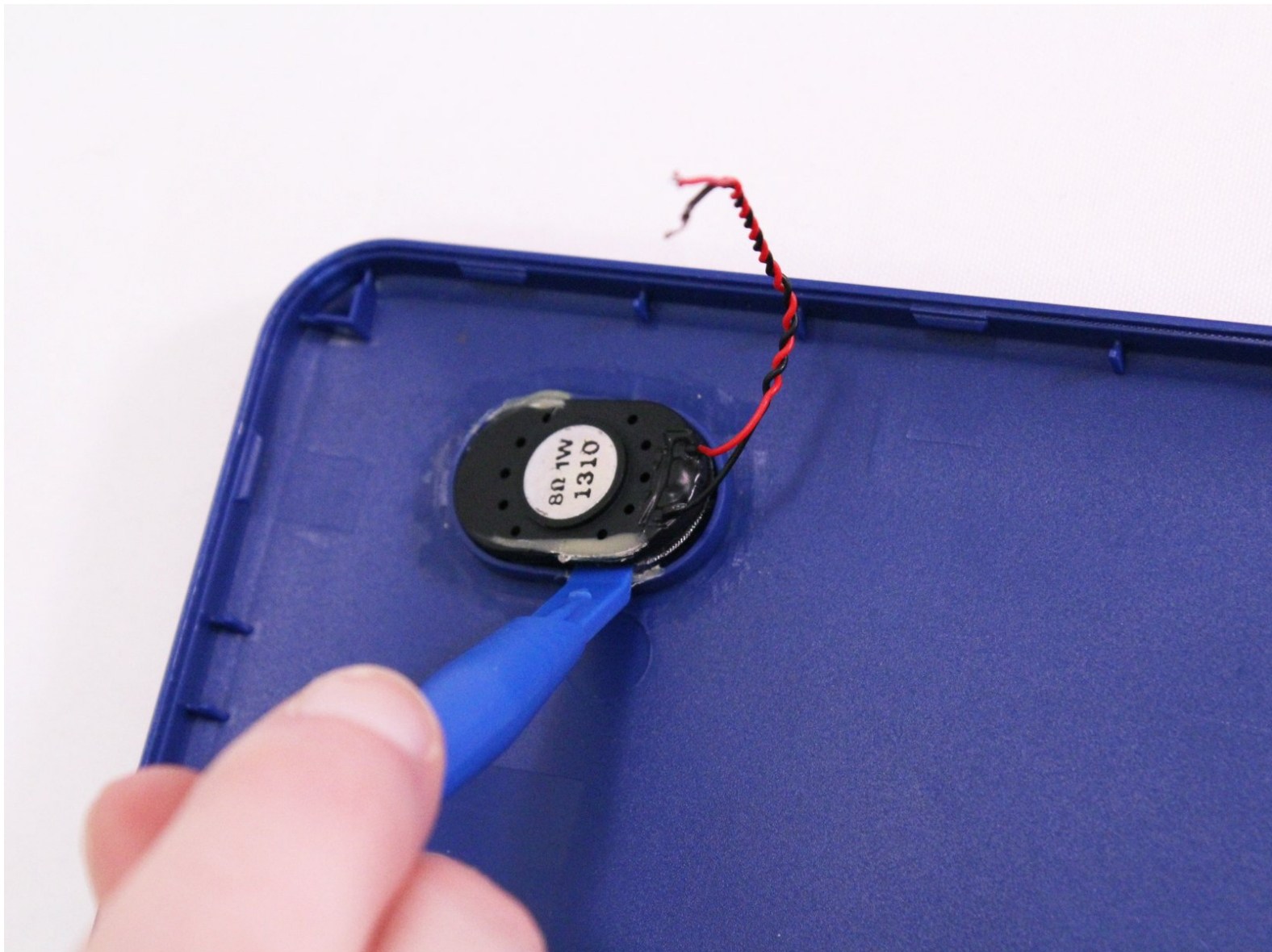




# ProScan PLT7223G Speakers Replacement

# INTRODUCTION

If your ProScan's audio is not working, use this guide to replace the speakers. This guide will require soldering.

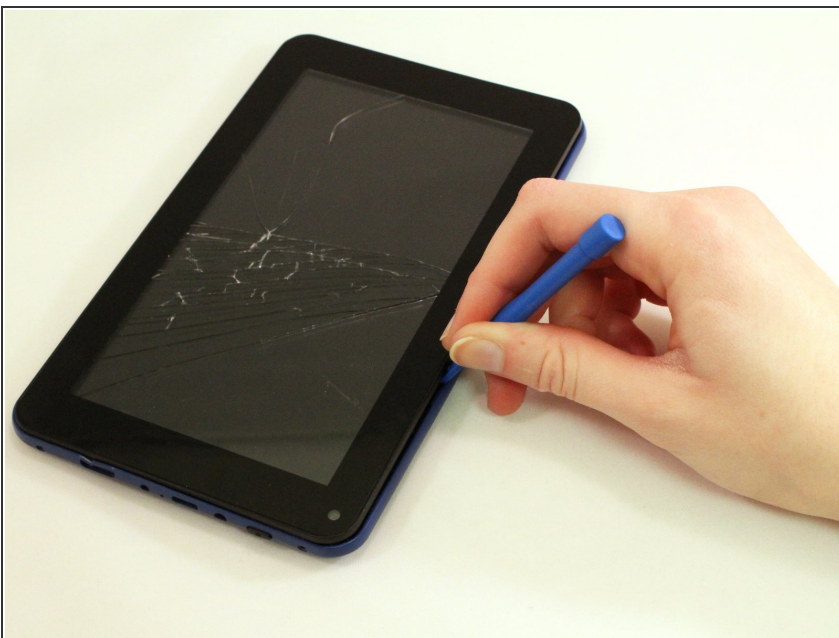

## Step 1 — Speakers



- Remove both 4 mm screws on the top of the tablet with a PH00 screw driver.

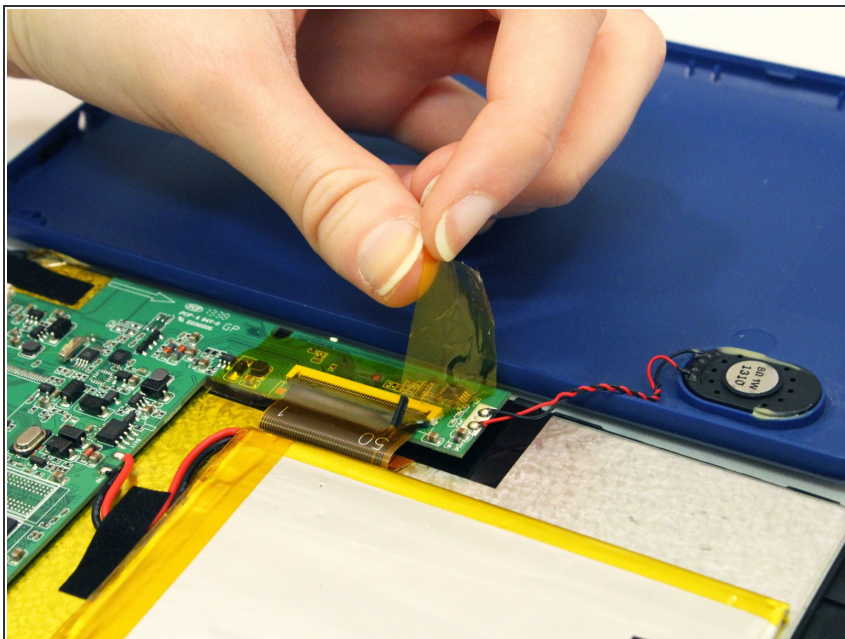
## Step 2



- Use the blue plastic opening tool to pry open the tablet.
- ⓘ You will hear popping sounds. That's okay.
- ⚠ Be careful when using the blue plastic opening tool on the side of the device near the speakers, as there is a wire here that connects the speakers to the motherboard.

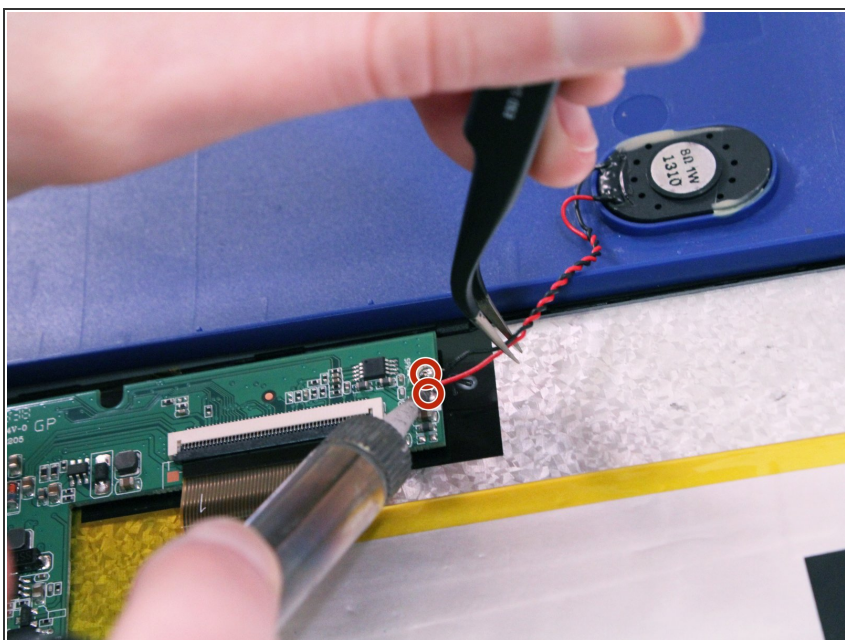


### Step 3



- Pull back the protective tape from the two wires that connect the speakers to the motherboard.

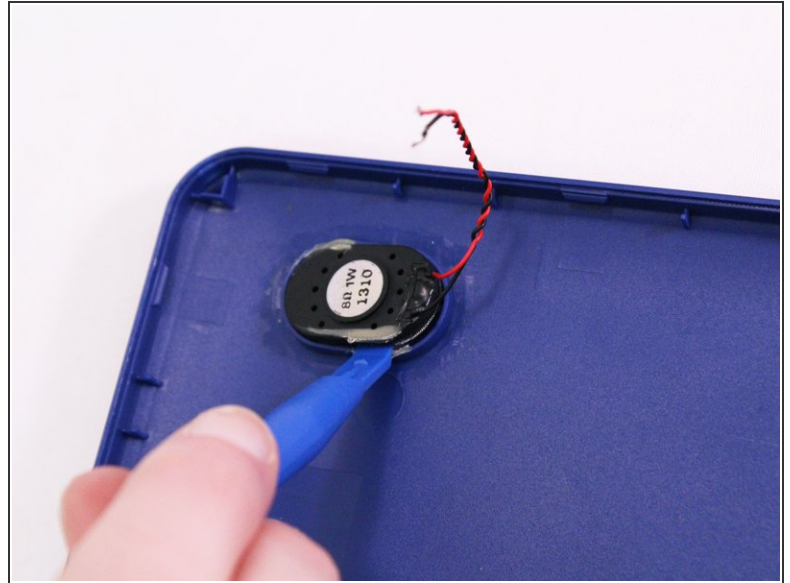
### Step 4



- Use the soldering tool to remove speaker wires from motherboard.

⚠ Soldering tool will get hot, handle with care.

## Step 5



- If needed use a plastic opening tool to remove speaker from the speaker port on the tablet.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
