### **INTRODUCTION**

In this guide, we are removing the fan from the base of the Ninja.



## **TOOLS:**


- T10 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

### **Step 1** — Base Disassembly




- Take out the three 15 mm Phillips #1 screws.
- Remove the 15mm T10 screw.
- Place the 4 screws on the magnetic mat.

## Step 2




 Remove the gray base by lifting upwards and placing to the side.


#### Step 3 — Fan



- Remove the central 15 mm length screw, you must hold the fan in place and use a flat head screw driver, twisting counterclockwise.
- Place this screw on the magnetic mat.

### Step 4





- Remove the fan from the motor by gently pulling upwards.
- A Be careful as to not damage any wires when removing the fan.
- Set the fan to the side.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
