



Hamilton Beach 48464 Base Replacement

This guide will show how to properly remove the base. This is important if your base has been cracked or broken in any way or a way to get inside of the coffee maker.

INTRODUCTION

Before starting, you should be sure to unplug the coffee maker. Also, be sure to empty all contents before making any repairs.

TOOLS:

- [Crown Bolt #8 Steel Spanner](#) (1)
 - [Phillips #2 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Base



- This is what the bottom cover will look like. Flip the Brew Station upside down to easily access the screws.

Step 2



- Using the Philips 2 Screwdriver, unscrew the three 8-mm screws labeled in a red outline.
- Using the Crown Bolt #8 Steel Spanner, unscrew the two 8-mm screws labeled in a orange outline.

Step 3



- Carefully slide off the bottom drip tray by sliding it out away from the Brew Station.

Step 4



- Gently lift the base away from the Brew Station.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
