


# ThinkPad X1 Carbon (2nd Gen) Battery Replacement

# **TOOLS:**

• Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Cover



- Remove the 7 philips head screws from the back.
- Lift off back cover.

## **Step 2** — **Battery Disconnection**



 Using a plastic pry tool disconnect the battery from the motherboard.

## Step 3 — Battery Removal





- Remove the five black phillips screws from the battery.
- The battery can now be removed from the laptop.
- (i) There is one in each corner and the center.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
