


# **Bosch 3727DEVS Motor Brushes Replacement**

Replacing the Motor Brushes with new ones. The motor brushes complete the circuit to the sanding pad, so it can rotate while sanding

## INTRODUCTION

Purchase a new motor brush. The sander should be unplugged from any power sources. Make sure you organize the removed screws, so you can reinstall them in the correct location.

<ul> <li>T20 Torx Screwdriver (1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Carbon-Brush Set (1)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>T10 Torx Screwdriver (1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Brush Holder (1)</li> </ul>


#### Step 1 — Motor Brushes



A Ensure that the power chord is <u>not</u> plugged into an outlet.

- Using the T20 Torx Screwdriver, remove the four 15.6 mm screws securing the top cover to the sander.
- Lift the top cover off the sander.

#### Step 2



• Remove the two white wires connected to each motor brush by pulling on the spade terminals.

### Step 3



- Using the T10 Torx Screwdriver, remove the four 9.7 mm screws securing the motor brushes to the housing.
- After the screws are removed, both motor brushes can be lifted out of their position by hand.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
