




ASUS VivoBook S300CA-BBI5T01 CMOS Battery Replacement

TOOLS:


- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — CMOS Battery




- Place the laptop upside down so that the bottom panel is facing upwards.

Step 2




- Unscrew the following 10 screws
 - Eight 5 mm Phillips head screws
 - Two 10 mm Phillips head screws

Step 3



- Carefully peel the panel off of the bottom of the laptop.

Step 4



- Carefully remove the CMOS battery from its port by lifting it upward.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
