


# **ZTE Speed Headphone Jack Replacement**


# INTRODUCTION

Everyone likes to listen to music right? Then we need to learn how to get to the headphone jack if it needs to be fixed.

## **TOOLS:**


- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Motherboard




Pull off back cover at bottom right corner.

#### Step 2



 Remove the seven 3.175mm Phillips head screws from the inner back located at the top, uppermiddle-right, middle-right, lower-right, and bottom.

#### Step 3



- With the plastic opening tool the spudger, gently pry off the inner back.
- Be careful not to pry it off too hard, as it is just a plastic covering.

# Step 4




 Remove the one 2.381mm Phillips head screw from the motherboard located in the upper-middle part of the phone next to the bottom left corner of the back camera.

#### Step 5




- Using the spudger, gently pry up all ZIF connectors
- ZIF connectors have a tiny tab that needs to be flipped up in order to safely remove the cable
- Using same spudger, gently pry up the orange flat top connector

#### Step 6



• Carefully take off motherboard.

### Step 7 — Headphone Jack



• Flip over motherboard to locate headphone jack circuit.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
