


Sony Handycam HDR-CX220 Display Screen Replacement

INTRODUCTION

The replacement of the screen is needed if the image on the screen is not the desired image or if the screen is physically damaged.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Battery



Push in the battery indicator.

Step 2




- Slide the battery out of the slot.
- To put the battery back in, line up the battery's metal part with the camera's and slide it in.

Step 3 — Camera's Body







- Use the Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the two 5mm screws.
- Use the Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the two 5mm screws.
- Use the Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the three 5mm screws.

Step 4








• Use the plastic opening tool to loosen the plastic case of the camcorder.


Step 5



- Use your hands to remove the plastic case.
- Gently pull on the case not to damage anything internally.


Step 6 — Display Screen






- Use the Phillips #0 screwdriver to remover the two (5mm) screws on the outer part and one (3mm) in the middle.
- In the second image, there is a second screw on the opposite side of the screen hinge. This screw is not shown, but must also be removed.


Step 7



- Use the plastic opening tool to remove the plastic case protecting the screen
- Pull it gently not to damage anything under the case









- Use the Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the 2 screws shown
- Use your hands to carefully unhook the screen from the highlighted hook

Step 9







- Use your hands to carefully remove the tape
- After removing the tape, pull on the wire disconnecting it from the screen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
