

Hamilton Beach 70730 Drive Shaft Replacement

Replace the drive shaft of your Hamilton Beach 70730 food processor.

INTRODUCTION

The drive shaft is essential and may possibly have a stripped gear, causing the blade not to turn. There are several steps in order to take this out and replace it. Beware of lubricant along the bottom of it.

TOOLS:

- 64 Bit Driver Kit (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Bowl



• Unscrew the cover by turning it counterclockwise.

Step 2



• Grab the scraper by the midsection to remove.



• Carefully remove the blades by lifting them off of the blade shaft.

Step 4




• Rotate the bowl counterclockwise to release it from the base.



(i) Make sure there is no food or grime along the outside of the bowl or the base.

Step 6 — Drive Shaft



- Using the metal spudger, remove the four adhesive plastic covers that hide the screws.
- (i) These covers are adhered to the screws.



 Remove any excess glue that is adhered to the screws with the precision tweezers.

Step 8



• Using a JIS #1 driver, remove the four 10 mm screws.



• Lift the driveshaft off of the base.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
