INTRODUCTION


If the handle has broken off of the device you will have to reattach it or a new handle depending on the damage to your handle. This guide will show you the necessary steps to do so.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- 10 mm triple square (1)

Step 1 — Handle



- ♠ Ensure device is turned off, unplugged, cooled down and clean before attempting any replacements.
- Start by unscrewing the triplesquare bolt.

Step 2



 Next, unscrew the Phillips #2 screw attaching it to the black handle.

Step 3



You can now pull the handle off of the griddler and reattach a working handle.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
