


Resetting the Netgear WGR64v9




Step 1 — Resetting the Netgear WGR64v9



- Rotate device so the back panel is facing you.
- Locate the reset button. It is located on the metal grating next to the antenna.

Step 2





- Push the reset button using a tool, along the lines of a pencil or paper clip, until you hear the button click.
- (i) The router has now reverted to original user name and password settings

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
