


# **Keurig K70 Limit Switch Replacement**

Use this guide to replace the Limit Switch in your Keurig K70.

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### **INTRODUCTION**

Use this guide to replace the Limit Switch that tells the Keurig that the K-Cup section is closed.



## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Limit Switch



 Open the K-Cup Holder by lifting the handle.

### Step 2



 While looking upwards from underneath the Keurig, remove the two 8mm Phillips #2 screws from underneath the black plastic "shroud".

### Step 3







 Remove the black plastic "shroud" by pushing inwards and then pulling upwards to disengage the plastic hooks that are not visible.

#### Step 4





Remove the two 10mm Phillips #1 screws from the switch.

### Step 5





Remove the switch by cuting the two connecting wires. Reconnect a replacement switch <u>using this</u> <u>guide to join wires with solder</u>, or <u>using this guide to solder connections</u>, or by using any other technique to connect wires.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
