


# **Astro Pyle PTBL7C Speakers Replacement**

A guide to replace the speakers of the Astro Pyle PTBL7C.

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### **INTRODUCTION**

This will guide you through the process of replacing your Astro Pyle PTBL7C's speakers.



## **TOOLS:**

- Desoldering Braid (1)
- Desoldering Pump (1)
- Portable Soldering Iron (1)
- Heavy-Duty Spudger (1)
- Tweezers (1)



## **PARTS:**

Astro Pyle PTBL7C Speakers (1)


### Step 1 — Case Separation





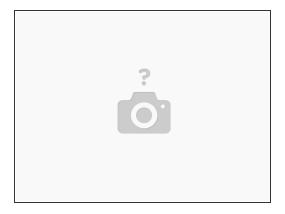
- Slide the flat end of the spudger under the front edge of the screen and carefully pry it open.
- (i) The front edge is the side with the buttons on it.
- You may hear a cracking sound when pulling the case off of the device. This is normal, and is just the clips being pulled apart. However, be careful and pull the clips slowly/cautiously to avoid damage.
- ↑ Be aware of the speaker cable when removing the case, as it is still attached to the motherboard.

#### Step 2 — Tape Removal



- Locate the Speakers; they should be attached to the case as shown.
- Follow the wires back to the motherboard, removing all tape covering the wires along the way.
- i This will make it easier to move the wires around.

## Step 3 — Desoldering Speakers



- Desolder the black wire from the motherboard. This will separate the speakers from the board, allowing you to replace them.
- Exercise EXTREME caution while soldering. It is very easy to burn yourself, or damage the surrounding components. For a basic guide of how to desolder, follow this link:
