INTRODUCTION

If one or both speakers on your tablet are not working properly, this guide will walk you through how to easily replace them.



Step 1 — Stereo Speakers



- Begin by separating the back panel from the screen glass assembly using the plastic opening tool.

Step 2




- Continue around the entire device until the back panel is completely separated from the screen.

Step 3



- Use a Phillips #000 screwdriver to remove the 2.5mm Phillips head screw on the top part of the speaker.

Step 4



- Using your fingers, carefully remove the tab that connects the speaker to the motherboard.

Step 5



- Using your fingers, gently remove the speaker from its place.

Step 6



- Use a Phillips #000 screwdriver to remove the 2.5mm Phillips head screw on top of the speaker.

Step 7




- Using your fingers, lift the tab that connects the speaker to the mother board.

Step 8



- Using a nylon spudger, gently lift the round piece that connects to the speaker and remove it from its place.

Step 9



- Using your fingers, gently remove the speaker from its place.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
