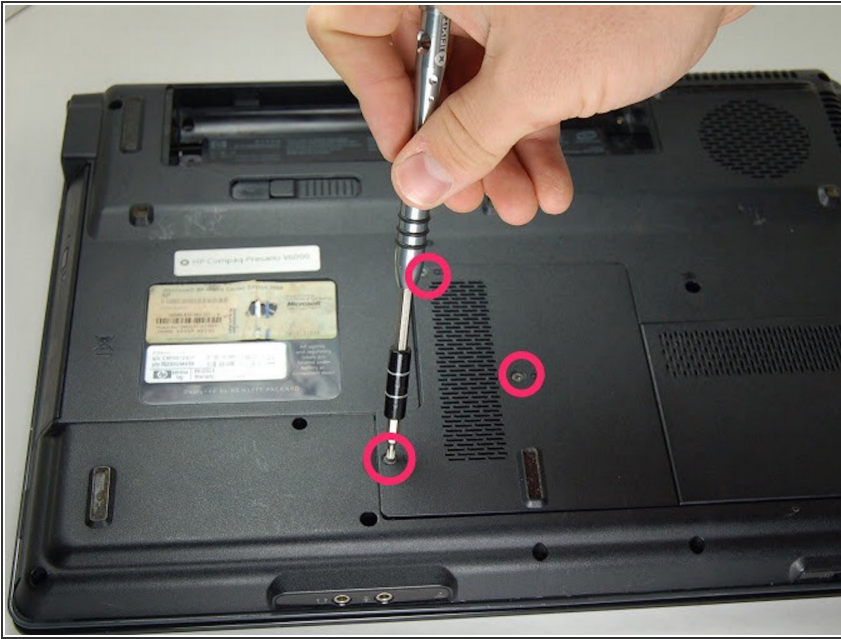

Step 1 — Wifi antenna card



- Grab a Type-Cross #1 screwdriver and unscrew the 3 screws and take off the cover of the wifi antenna card.

Step 2



- Use your finger tips to pry off the gray antenna connections.
- ⚠ Be careful to not pull the antenna wire too hard, you may cause damage to the connection permanently and/or motherboard.
- ⓘ The screwdriver is only being use to demonstrate which wire to remove. The screwdriver can potentially damage the motherboard if used improperly.

Step 3



- After removing the connection cable, remove the two screws that hold the wireless card to the motherboard.
- Then gently remove card without causing any damage to card itself or surrounding parts.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
