


# **Toshiba NB305 Wifi Card Replacement**

Replace your wifi card so that you can again roam the world wirelessly.

# **INTRODUCTION**

We will show you how to find and remove the wifi card. This is a simple procedure and only requires a few steps.



# TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- T6 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

# Step 1 — Battery



 Place the laptop upside down with the battery facing you.

# Step 2



 Use your right hand to move latch 1 to the right to unlock the battery.

# Step 3





- Use your left hand to hold latch 2 to the left.
- Simultaneously take the battery out with your right hand.

# Step 4 — Wifi Card







- Locate the two torx T-6 screws on the back of the laptop and remove them.
  - 6mm Torx T-6 Screws

# Step 5





Using a spudger pry the panel up.

# Step 6





- Using a spudger pry up and off the two wire connections.
- (i) Note that the black wire is on the top of the card and the white is the bottom.

# Step 7





- Remove the two Phillips 0 size screws on WIFI card.
- Once the screws are removed the WIFI card will raise up

# Step 8





- Grip both sides of the wifi card with your hand.
- Lift up on the card and pull the card out of the slot

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
