


# **Uniden UTAB71 Camera Replacement**

## **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will explain how to replace the camera in this tablet. If there is any confusion about removing the battery, see the battery replacement guide.



### **TOOLS:**

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Plastic Cards (1)
- Solder (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)
- iOpener (1)

#### Step 1 — Camera





- Use a plastic pry tool to separate the two halves of the tablet.
- (i) Make sure to be gentle with the pry tool and work your way around the edges of the tablet slowly.
- Make sure the tablet is powered off before prying open.
- ↑ There are two power ribbons connecting the screen to the back of the tablet. Make sure not to put too much stress on them.


#### Step 2





- Use a credit card to lift the battery off the back of the tablet.
- ♠ Do not put any pressure on the motherboard or any other internal components.
- The battery is glued onto the back of the tablet so make sure to apply as much pressure as needed


#### Step 3



 Undo the clips off the power ribbon connecting the camera to the motherboard using the blue pry tool.

## Step 4



- Use the pry tool to remove the yellow tape from the power ribbon connected to the camera.
- Place the plastic pry tool under the camera component and lift it off the tablet.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
