




# Le Pan II Battery Replacement



## Step 1 — Screen



- Insert metal spudger between front and back panel to pry apart.
- Continue to pry while moving the metal spudger along the crevice to completely separate two panels.



 Avoid using metal when opening devices, as it can damage or crack the screen.

## Step 2




- Use the plastic opening tool to disconnect the flat ribbon cable from the motherboard connector.
- Disconnect the flat ribbon by gently pulling it out from its connecting port.

## Step 3



- Use the plastic opening tool to disconnect the display cable from its motherboard connector.
- Disconnect the display cable by gently pulling it out from its connecting port.

## Step 4



- Remove grey metal backing from screen.

## Step 5



- Flip the tablet so the screen is facing upward, and use the metal spudger to pry apart the screen from the side pieces.
