


# VTechCS6719-16 Button Replacement

This is a guide that locates and replaces the inner buttons of the phone.

### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide demonstrates a walk-through of steps needed to completely dismantle the phone in order to locate the buttons and replace them with new ones.



## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)

### Step 1 — Buttons



Remove the sliding back cover from case.

## Step 2



 lift the battery and unplug the two pin cable from phone base.

### Step 3




 Remove the two 10mm screws at the base of the phone.

### Step 4



- Use the spudger along the edge using a firm but gentle lifting motion.
- When doing this feel for the hooks that latch the phones front and back cases.

### Step 5




 Unscrew a second set of 10mm screws to obtain access to the other side.

#### Step 6



- i The front of the phone can now be placed to the side
  - You will notice the button covers, these display the numerical values and positions of each button
  - These can be placed aside as they will get in the way later.

### Step 7



- Now the silicon pads for the phone buttons are exposed.
- These can easily be removed by pulling away the pads from the circuit board.
- To replace simply align the new pad onto the button positions.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
