INTRODUCTION

This guide will teach how to remove and replace the disk tray.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Disk Tray



 Use the Phillips Head #2 screwdriver to remove the three 10mm screws on the back panel.

Step 2







- Use the plastic spudger to pry open the top panel.
 - A Be careful not to break the ribbon connecting the motherboard on the bottom panel to the top panel.

Step 3






Pull the ribbons gently from one corner by the blue tabs to remove it.

Step 4



 Remove the two 7.5 screws on both sides of the disk tray with Phillips Head #2 screwdriver.

Step 5





- Push two small prongs on both sides inwards and push forward.
- Remove the disk tray.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
