
TOOLS:

64 Bit Driver Kit (1)

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)


Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Case



- Remove the 18 Phillips screws using a screwdriver with a PH0 bit.

Step 2




- Using a spudger, gently pry open the back from the top.

Step 3 — Battery



- Once it is opened up, locate the battery and the cable that is attached to it.

Step 4



- Next, unscrew the battery pack. The one screw should be located on the far right of it. This will ensure that the battery comes out easily and affectively.

Step 5



- Take the battery out easily for replacement.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
